Datasets

There are a number of heritage features within the Evenlode catchment. The different heritage datasets displayed on the map are described below.

Conservation Areas - locations of special architectural and historical interest.

Heritage at Risk - historical features in or at risk of deterioration.

World Heritage Sites - a landmark or area recognised as being of outstanding international importance and receives special protection.

Registered Battlefields - battlefields of national and historical significance.

Registered Parks and Gardens - significant gardens, grounds and other planned open spaces with emphasis on the design of the garden over planting or botanical importance.

Scheduled Monuments - nationally important archaeological sites that are carefully managed.

The data shown on the map are freely available from Historic England. There are more detailed, site-specific datasets available from the Historic Environment Record centres from each local council that provide further information on particular locations.
